

### 인칭대명사





- **○** I my mine he – his – his
- you your yours
- she her hers
- we our ours
- they their theirs

인칭대명사에는 '~의 것'이라는 소유의 의미를 나타내는 격이 있어요. 'my pencil(내 연필)'은 '나의 것 (mine)'에 해당해요. my는 소유격. mine은 소유대명사라 불러요.

- This is my ruler. It is **mine**. (= my ruler) Your bread is small. **Hers** is big. (= Her bread)
- Those tools are his. (= his tools)
- The house is **theirs**, not **ours**.

- I myself bake bread. (나 자신)
- We look at **ourselves** in the mirror. (우리 자신)
- Help yourself. (마음껏 드세요.)
- He cleans his classroom by himself. (혼자서)
