인칭대명사에는 ‘~의 것’이라는 소유의 의미를 나타내는 격이 있어요. ‘my pencil(내 연필)’은 ‘나의 것 (mine)’에 해당해요. my는 소유격, mine은 소유대명사라 불러요.

- This is my ruler. It is **mine**. (= my ruler)
- Your bread is small. **Hers** is big. (= Her bread)
- Those tools are **his**. (= his tools)
- The house is **theirs**, not **ours**.

인칭대명사에는 ‘~ 자신’이라는 의미의 재귀대명사도 있어요. 재귀대명사는 문장에서 다양한 표현과 의미로 쓰여요.

- I **myself** bake bread. (나 자신)
- We look at **ourselves** in the mirror. (우리 자신)
- Help **yourself**. (마음껏 드세요.)
- He cleans his classroom **by himself**. (혼자서)


