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Foreword

토플을 단순히 시험으로만 생각하는 사람이 의외로 많다. 그래서 토플을 대하는 요령이나 방법을 배우려 하는 사람을 어렵지 않게 찾아볼 수 있다. 하지만 토플은 시험이기 전에 영어라는 언어이다. 무엇보다도 TOEFL iBT Speaking은 언어에 대한 이해 없이 단순한 암기나 요령으로는 좋은 결과를 얻기 어렵다. TOEFL iBT는 본인의 생각을 조리 있게 표현할 수 있는 능력(TASK 1 & 2), 읽고 들은 내용을 종합해서 말할 수 있는 능력(TASK 3 & 4), 그리고 대학 생활이나 교수의 강의 내용을 정리하고 paraphrase 할 수 있는 능력(TASK 5 & 6)을 요구한다. TASK 1 & 2는 기본적인 영어 실력만 갖춰져 있다면 고득점을 획득할 수 있다. 하지만 TASK 3 -6 까지의 문제들을 풀기 위해서는 단순히 말하기 능력만 필요한 것이 아니라 지문을 빠른 시간 내에 읽고 정리할 수 있는 능력과 듣기 능력을 필요로 한다.

토플을 준비하는 학생들이 가장 먼저 생각해야 할 것은 어휘 능력이다. 토플을 공부함과 동시에 좋은 토플 어휘 책을 구입해서 꾸준히 암기해야 한다. 또한 매일 50분 이상은 듣기 연습을 해야 한다. 대학 생활을 바탕으로 한 영화나 미국 대학 (하버드, 예일, MIT, NYU, etc)에서 제공하는 무료 수업을 청강하는 것도 좋은 방법이다. 대부분의토플 스피킹 문제가 대학 생활에 관련된 문제이기에 직접적인 관련이 있는 내용을 듣는 것이 더 현명할 수 있겠다. 대학 강의를 들을 때는 여러 강의를 많이 듣는 것 보다 들었던 강의를 반복해서 들으면서 강의를 이해하는 감각을 높이는 것이 중요하다. 반복해서 청취하다 보면 들리는 내용이 조금씩 많아 진다. 그 때부터는 Dictation 연습을통해 강의 내용을 정리하는 연습을 하자.

이와 함께, New Edition Hooked On TOEFL iBT Speaking책에서 제공하는 학습 방법을 체계적으로 익히기 바란다. 갑자기 어떤 어려운 주제나 학습분야에 관해서 토론을 해야 한다면 스피킹이 어렵게 느껴질 수도 있겠지만 New Edition Hooked On TOEFL iBT Speaking에서 제공하는 가장 기본적인 표현법을 응용해서 패턴 드릴을 연습하다 보면 나도 모르는 사이에 자연스럽게 영어로 생각을 표현하고 편안하게 말 할 수 있는 실력을 갖출 수 있을 것이다.





Tip Task 1 does not require you to make complicated sentences. Rather, it is designed to evaluate your ability to make simple but grammatically well-structured sentences. So, your main concern is to make clear, concise and sensible sentences quickly. As soon as you read the question, you should come up with a topic sentence right away.


