TEPS reading의 Part I에서는 총 16문항이 출제되며, 1~14번의 문제는 빈칸에 들어갈 내용을 찾는 문항이, 15~16번에서는 적절한 연결어 찾기가 출제된다. 연결어든, 빈칸의 내용이든 전체적인 내용의 흐름을 파악하고, 빈칸의 앞·뒤 문장이 갖는 논리적 관계를 파악하는 능력이 공통적으로 요구된다. 글의 주제 및 전체적 흐름을 파악하고, 문단 내에서 이뤄지는 순접, 역접, 인과의 논리 관계를 이해하는 능력을 Part I에서 훈련하도록 해보자.

빈칸 채우기 - 첫 문장 완성하기

▼ 출제방식

완결된 글에는 대부분 주제문이 있다. 평이한 글에서는 주제문이 가장 앞에 나오는 경우가 많으며, 그렇기 때문에 빈칸이 가장 앞에 있을 경우 선택지 중에서 글의 주제문이나 핵심 사항을 찾으라는 얘기로 보아도 무방하다. 지문 전체를 축약한 내용이 빈칸으로 출제될 경우 지문 전체를 모두 읽어야 문제를 해결할 수 있다. 단, 첫 문장이 주제문과 반대되는 경우도 있으니 끝까지 신중하게 읽어야 한다.

[해설] 아파트의 입주자를 대상으로 한 공지다. 빈칸에는 문맥상 직원들이 내일 할 일이 들어가야 하며, 따라서 빈칸에 들어갈 내용이 바로 공지의 목적이 된다. we want to make sure everyone stays warm과 take away anything blocking the heater를 보면 직원들이 할 일은 주민들이 겨울철을 따뜻하게 날 수 있도록 보일러의 성능을 확인하는 일임을 알 수 있다. 직원들이 아파트에 들어간다는 사실을 추론할 수는 있으나 공지의 중심 내용이 아니므로 (a)는 오답이며, 새 난방기를 설치하는 것이 아니라 기존의 난방기가 잘 작동하는지 점검하는 것이므로 (c)도 오답이다.

▼ 출제방식

빈칸이 중간에 오는 경우 역시 주제문과 관련해 주제문의 논리적 흐름을 이어갈 수 있는지를 묻는 경우가 많다. 때문에, 빈칸을 제외한 전체 글의 내용을 통해, 또는 글의 서두의 내용을 읽으면서 주제문을 밝혀야 한다. 하지만 첫 번째 문장이 주제문을 강조하기 위해 반복하는 내용이 나올 수 있으므로 무조건 시작 부분을 주제문으로 생각하는 것은 바람직하지 않으며, 글의 중간에 반전이 있어서 마지막에 가서야 주제문이 등장한다면, 주어진 빈칸이 반전이 있기 전인지 후인지를 판단해야 한다.
